Relocating the Warren Central Polling Location: Krystle Ransom, Director of Elections gave a brief overview of why the county would like to move this voting location.

First this is a safety concern as twice a year the doors off Fourth Ave., remain open which allows anyone from the public to slip into the building without going through single point; which is our main entrance into the building.


Krystle Ransom, Director of Elections stated that she did have a talk with the Salvation Army and they are on board with moving this precinct to their building with the others; there is adequate room.

She then stated that with the combined precincts at Holy Redeemer which has approximately 3,000 voters passing through, this move would have approximately 2,000 voters passing through.
