

Ordinance 1-2022 Creation of the Warren County Landbank: Commissioner Jeff Eggleston reviewed the landbank, and what its powers are.

This will help take care of blight throughout the county more efficiently. He went on to state that there will be an intergovernmental agreement signed by the municipalities, showing their support in the fact that once a blighted property gets taken care of, they will maintain the property such as mowing etc. and for the next five years 50% of the taxes will go to the landbank to keep it funded.
